## EMPLOYMENT IN SHOPS AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS

G.O. (2D) No. 30, Labour & Employment (J1), dated 29/05/2013, Notification No. II (2)/LE/ 472/2013, Published in Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, Part II, Section 2, dated 10/7/2013, at pages 467-469

## **EXPLANATIONS:**

## DEARNESS ALLOWANCE:

In addition to the minimum rates of basic wages fixed herein, the employees shall be paid dearness allowance as indicated below:

- (i) The Dearness Allowance is linked to the Average Consumer Price Index of Chennai City for the year 2000, that is, 475 points (with base 1982=100), and for any further rise of every one point over and above 475 points, an increase of ₹ 4.95 (Rupees four and paise ninety five only) per month shall be paid as Dearness Allowance.
- (ii) The Dearness Allowance shall be calculated every year on the 1st April on the basis of the average of the indices for the preceding 12 months, that is, from January to December, and
- (iii) The first calculation of the dearness allowance shall thus be effective from the date of publication of this notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette based on the average of Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the previous year, that is from January to December.
- 2. Classification of Zones, shall be as follows:

Zone A: Corporations and Special Grade Municipalities.

Zone B: Municipalities other than Special Grade Municipalities.

Zone C : All Townships, Town Panchayats and Cantonments.

Zone D: All places other than those mentioned in Zones A, B and C.

- Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made between men and women employees.
- To arrive at the daily rate of wages, the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.
- Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein such higher wages shall be continued to be paid.

Apart from the minimum rates of basic wages detailed herein the dearness allowance payable for the period from 01/04/2016 to 31/03/2017 shall be ₹ 3,727.00 per month.
